

## London Architect: Macros

BSS Soundweb London is a programmable DSP system with control and audio networking on a single Cat 5 cable. On offer is a free-design programmable DSP system that allows the creation of virtually any audio system design, and places no restrictions on signal path, sub-mixing or object location.

In BSS' new release of HiQnet London Architect software (version 1.14), the use of Macros has been added. So, what can Macros do for you?

A Macro within London Architect is basically a group of processing blocks represented by a single icon. It facilitates faster system design, more control, and a simplified overview for installers and end-users alike.

Utilising the new Macro Editor Application, multiple processing blocks (and associated control pages) can be created and saved within a single Macro block. This allows commonly used functions to be grouped together, available for use across all your future system designs. This process also gives you the ability to share Macros with other designers, with an average file size of about 250 KB.

Once entered into a design, the only parameters that can be edited by users are those you decide to put on your control page. You could, for example, completely hide elements such as limiting, speaker tunings and system equalisation, whilst giving control of basic EQ and system level.
